CHAMPAGNE



In the 'Comet Year' of 1811 and just 12 months after their nuptials, young newlyweds Pierre- Nicolas Perrier and Adèle Jouët created a Champagne House in Epernay through which their love story would continue throughout time. Today, from the same address and using the same buildings & cellars that the couple created, Perrier-Jouët continues to create enchanting, seductive and delicate Champagnes in the style created in unison by the founding couple.

Perrier Jouët Grand Brut

A blend of fifty different Crus, Perrier-Jouët Grand Brut expresses the quality and diversity of the House winemaking tradition. Its assemblage creates a balance between the consistency of the Perrier-Jouët style and the effects of the climate of the year. With 12 to 20% of reserve wines added, Perrier-Jouët Grand Brut is dominated by the elegance and finesse of the Chardonnay (20%) from the best vineyards in the Côte des Blancs. The delicate structure is brought by the Pinot Noir (40%) primarily sourced from the Montagne de Reims and the Vallée de la Marne, but also from the best Crus in the Aube region such as Les Riceys. Pinot Meunier (40%) from the Vallée de la Marne brings harmony, fruit and roundness to the wine.

Perrier Jouët Blason Rose

The Cellar Master seeks apleness and structure in this cuvée, in search of a gourmet blend which must nevertheless retain a certain freshness. A marriage which demands the precision of a specialist in order to bring out the elegance of style that is the hallmark of Perrier-Jouët champagne. The choice of Crus is carefully adjusted according to the harvest. An addition of 12 to 15% of reserve wines creates the consistency required to balance the Perrier-Jouët style with the climatic effects of the year. Built on the model of the Perrier- Jouët Grand Brut, which is driven by the intensity of the Chardonnay in the blend, Perrier- Jouët Blason Rosé is enriched by the addition of red wines. The elegance and finesse of the Chardonnay (25%), blend with the structure of the Pinot Noir (50% including the added red wines) and the fruitiness of Pinot Meunier (25%) – a grape with which Perrier-Jouët has acquired specific expertise.

While preserving the House style, Hervé Deschamps blended this cuvée to emphasise the unique character of the 2011 vintage. His blend brings out the freshness and elegance of the Chardonnay (50%) from the grands crus of Cramant and Avize. From the Montagne de Reims, the Pinot Noir (45%) display a generosity and delicate complexity that prolong the Chardonnay's finesse. Finally, the rounded charm of the Pinot

ROSE CHAMPAGNE**Billecart – Salmon Rose, Brut, NV**

Produced using a blend of wines from three separate vintages and includes three different grape varieties: 30% Chardonnay, 40% Pinot Noir and 30 % Pinot Meunier. The result is a Champagne with a fine, effervescent mousse that offers up flavours of peach and pear, with hint of raspberry and citrus zest. It is aged on its lees for 36 months – adding a creamy texture. The finish is long, with lingering notes of raspberry. Excellent as an aperitif or when paired with seafood.

Bollinger Rose, Brut, NV

A recently introduced pink champagne from one of the grandest of the Grandes Marques, Bollinger Rose is particularly fine, fruity & full-flavoured. A subtle combination of structure, length and vivacity, with a tannic finish due to the adjunction of red wine. Bubbles as fine as velvet. A fabulous pink fizz with flavours of wild berries.

Showing tropical fruit and blood orange, alongside notes of violets and wonderful richness, this is a truly extraordinary champagne.

Louis Roederer Rose 2012

The pure, precise bouquet mingles sweet flowers (honeysuckle and lily), slightly acid red fruits (redcurrant, wild strawberry) and citrus zest (mandarin). Warm, deeply reassuring and inviting notes then appear with a smokiness and ripeness typical of Louis Roederer.

Owned by the family since 1891, the estate comprises vines at a wide variety of altitudes, with wines running all the way down to the banks of the River Piava. To this phenomenon the estate credits the delicate floral aromas of their Glera and Pinot Grigio grapes which give a delicate nose of strawberry and raspberry with a crisp and fresh finish.

This extraordinary wine is produced from grapes grown on the Tommasi 'Fiorato' plot. Very low yielding vines produce tiny volumes of grapes and following a rigorous drying process and ageing in barrels for 12 months. Retaining a high residual sugar and pleasant fruitiness it is a superb dessert wine.
