A delicate blend of mainly Chardonnay and Pinot Noir with a touch of Pinot Meunier Meunier. The champagne has finesse and elegance but a good weight and length on the finish.	Jeroboam 360

Owned by the family since 1891, the estate comprises vines at a wide variety of altitudes, with wines running all the way down to the banks of the River Piava. To this phenomenon the estate credits the delicate floral aromas of their Glera and Pinot Grigio grapes which give a delicate nose of strawberry and raspberry with a crisp and fresh finish.

## SPARKLING RED

**Majella, Sparkling Shiraz, Coonawarra, Australia, 2020** 80

Majella is a vibrant deep red and the bouquet has oak derived vanilla, plums and spice. The palate is luscious with plum, cherry and raspberry fruit characters shining through and has tannin, acid and sugars balanced in just the right amounts. The wine is disgorged with a small amount of "liqueur" is added which is true Aussie tradition they use some really fantastic vintage port.

An award winning Sauvignon from the heart of the Loire. Crisp, zesty and full of citrus fruit.
- 104 **Muscadet Sevre et Maine sur Lie, Ch. Haute Cariziere, 2020** 34  
An exceptional wine with seafood. Crisp, dry and wonderfully refreshing with extra lift from 'sur lie' ageing.
- 105 **Muscadet-Sèvre-et Maine sur Lie “Garance” PM&M Luneau, 2020** 39  
100% Melon de Bourgogne. Great value, everyday drinking bone-dry white. The character is lean; fruit is saline lemon, with a zesty, prickly acidity. Smoky and bread-y on the nose with added texture from extended time on the lees. 2019 marks Luneau's first vintage with official organic accreditation, and a move towards lowering the additional sulphites added to the wine.
- 106 **Sancerre, Domaine Pierre Martin, 2021** 42  
Quintessential Sauvignon Blanc; cut grass, gooseberries and blackcurrant leaves. Great with seafood.
- 107 **Pouilly Fumé, Domaine Jonathan & Didier Pabiot, 2019** 45  
Complex, top notch Pouilly Fumé with subtle lingering flavours. A wine that is much in demand.

Family owned – unique climate close to Montpellier – rich, apricot, pear & white blossom.
- 109 **Picpoul de Pinet, Terre de Roqueloupie, 2020** 34  
Perfect partner for all types of seafood and also very elegant as an aperitif, featuring a delicious, fresh palate showcasing hints of grapefruit and other citrus note.
- 110 **Gleason Domaine Vallee Du Paradis Blanc, 2017** 38  
A pale color with golden highlights. Light citrus and floral nose a balance between fruit and yeast. Tastes of lemon, cookies and a touch of lavender with a medium acidity and long dry finish. Very interesting wine, blend of three fantastic grapes: Chardonnay, Roussanne, Vermentino, all together gives not an everyday wine.

A complex bouquet of citrus fruits, honey and hazelnuts blend with the rich vanilla oak. A lovely example of this highly sought after wine.

Complex with creamy characters and zippy lemon and green flavours. Long dusty, mineral finish with hints of fennel and flint. Very floral with touches of white peach, flint, smoke and lemon peel.

Merlot dominated blend, backed up by Cabernet Sauvignon as well as a small dose of Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. Aged in a combination of oak barrels and stainless steel tanks, the resulting wine possesses a fine nose with aromas of red berries, leading to a supple & elegant palate. A spectacular wine with with fine balance and long finish.
- 304 **Segla, 2<sup>nd</sup> Wine of Château Rauzan-Segla, Margaux, 2014** 90  
A wine that shows its pedigree, this is attractive, with fragrant black berry fruit coming through on both the nose and palate. The tannins are silky-fine and ripe, lending a subtle structure. On the finish, there are smoky notes of cedar wood and spice, giving this a beguiling complexity.

## **BEAUJOLAIS RED**

- 305 **Fleurie Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Lardy, 2019** 42  
The exceptionally old vines produce very small yields of tremendously concentrated juice. Following careful barrel ageing, the resultant wine is one of the best to be found in Beaujolais

- 117 **Grillo, Feudo Arancio, Sicily, 2020** 29  
Tropical notes of mango and papaya combine beautifully with hints of jasmine and acacia flavours. This Grillo offers real pleasure and an elegance rarely seen in this variety. Good balance of the sweet flavours of tropical fruits with the acidity.
- 118 **Pinot Grigio, Tre Fili, Provincial de Pavia, 2020** 27  
Pinot Grigio offering a refreshing, fruity style with plenty of character. Vibrant green apple and pear flavours with a touch of elderflower

## ITALY ROSE

- 203 **Calafuria Salento IGT, Negroamaro, Tormaresca, Puglia, 2020** 40  
This wine shows intense fragrances of pink grapefruit, peach and violets. The flavour is fresh with savoury notes. As fresh and refreshing as a sunny afternoon in Southern Italy.

## ITALY RED

- 306 **Corvina, Castelforte, Veneto, 2018** 32  
Softly dry, with hints of black cherry and blackberry. Spicy on the nose melts with raisin on the palette. A great balanced wine.
- 307 **Domini Del Leone, Rosso di Veneto, Veneto, 2019** 27  
A combination of Corvina, Raboso and Merlot, the "rosso" is a soft medium bodied wine that offers satisfying juicy cherry notes with hints of cranberries.
- 308 **'Cinquenoci' Primitivo, Masseria Tagaro, Puglia, 2020** 39  
A deep red with violet reflections. Intense and persistent aromas of red fruit on the nose. Very strong notes of plum, blackcurrant, cocoa and sweet spices. Well balanced wine with great complexity, juicy tannins and long lasting finish.
- 309 **Peppoli Chianti Classico, Antonori, Tuscany, 2019** 45  
Intense red aromas of cherry, strawberries are offset by delicate notes of vanilla and chocolate. Pleasant with a lingering fresh vibrant feel in the mouth.

- 119 **Rioja Blanco, Bodegas Altanza, DO Rioja, 2020** 32  
A new style of Rioja Blanco made with 100% Sauvignon Blanc exhibiting superb greenage and gooseberry fruit with a very fresh finish.
- 120 **Godello Ondas del Alma, Monterrei DO (Galicia), 2020** 38  
This superb Godello is produced by the Adegas Pazo das Tapias winery. Pale yellow white, with notes of tropical fruit on the nose dominated by peach. Very well balanced, with medium intensity and a very silky, crisp finish. Perfect paired with seafood.
- 121 **Albarino, Chan de Rosas Clasico, Rias Baixas, 2020** 38  
Fresh, crisp wine that displays elegant white flower and citrus notes, backed up by white peach and crisp acidity. Perfect as an aperitif or as a traditional accompaniment to seafood.
- 122 **O Rosal Albarino, Terras Gauda, Rias Baixas, 2020** 40  
A selective blend of the best Albarino grapes in the O Rosal subzone is mixed with the indigenous Loureira and Caino Blanco. Look for ripe peach, aromatic herbs, hints of bay leaf and mint, orange blossom, mandarin and orange peel

## SPAIN RED

- 310 **Tempranillo - Rioja Crianza, Marques de Tomares, Rioja, 2018** 35  
Made by one of the best producers in Rioja Alta, this smooth but full-bodied Tempranillo is bursting with jammy flavours and soft cinnamon spices.
- 311 **Ribera del Duero 15 meses Barrica, Diaz Bayo, Duero, 2018** 37  
A Spanish red of brute force, this powerful wine shows a deep colour, ripe aromas of plum and prune and plenty of chocolate and toasty oak flavours.

## PORTUGAL

### PORTUGAL WHITE

- 125 **Vinho Verde, Adega de Moncao, 2020** 30  
Vinho Verde is named from the colour of the grapes when they are harvested. Vinho Verde is crisp, lower in alcohol and with a touch of petillance (very slight sparkle). This example is a delight with its floral, citrus character and bright lemon acidity.

## GERMANY

### GERMANY WHITE

- 123 **Weisser Burgunder "S" Trocken, Schafer – Frohlich, Nahe, 2018** 45  
Tim Frohlich was named recently winemaker by the Gault-Millau- German guide and winemaker of the year. His obsession for minerality has become the hallmark of Schafer-Frohlich wines. This Weissergunder (Pinot Blanc) is the perfect example. Zesty green-apple and crushed mineral tones on the nose extend into crisp lime and lemon on the palate, finishes with hint of smoke.
- 124 **Riesling Dry, Schafer-Frohlich, Nahe, 2018** 39  
This dry example is bursting with juicy lemons, limes, pepper, orange peel and a long mineral finish.

## BULGARIA

### BULGARIA RED

- 312 **Soli Pinot Noir Edoardo Miroglio, Thracian Valley, 2019** 33  
Showcasing Bulgarian potential – Italian influence – Burgundy – like conditions. Edoardo, who was originally a textile manufacturer in his native Italy. This Pinot Noir offers succulent cherry, rhubarb and sweet strawberry located with cinnamon and sandalwood notes.

# SOUTH AFRICA

## SOUTH AFRICA WHITE

- 126 **Chenin Blanc, Cannonberg, Western Cape, 2021** 26  
Crisp, zesty and full of fruit. From cool vineyards in the Breede River Valley mountains north of Cape Town.
- 127 **Moment of Silence, Blankbottle, Wellington, 2021** 44  
A blend of Chenin Blanc, Grenache and Viognier - aromas of candied lemon, cooked apple and mango with a core of minerality. Soft and voluptuous, it has a lovely ripeness and a fleshy, creamy mouthfeel, which leads to a perfect tangy freshness giving some zip to its otherwise mellow feel.

# LEBANON

## LEBANON WHITE

- 128 **Blanc de L'Observatoire, Château Ksara, Bekaa Valley, 2019** 36  
Produced from Sauvignon blanc, Clairette and Muscat. A versatile, easy drinking wine. Simple but elegant character of peach, pear, banana and wild flowers. Very interesting and pleasant wine, perfect for summer.

## LEBANON ROSE

- 204 **Gris de Gris, Château Ksara, Bekaa Valley, 2019** 38  
A lush elegant rose from Grenache and Carignan. An aromatic nose of berries, vine flowers, peony and touch of jasmine. The fresh balanced body reveals hints of grapefruit, citrus and roses with bone dry finish. Not a classic rose but worth to try.

## LEBANON RED

- 313 **Réserve du Couvent, Château Ksara, Bekaa Valley, 2018** 38  
Syrah, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon. The backbone of the Château Ksara range which owes its inspiration to the wines of the Northern Rhone and Bordeaux. Aromas of fruit with a touch of leather, vanilla and smokiness on the end.

# CHILE

## CHILE WHITE

- 129 **Gewurztraminer, One to One Estate Reserve, Morande, 2021** 32  
This superb expression manages to capture all of Gewurztraminer's exotic character while remaining fresh and elegant. Aromas of rose and orange blossom lead to flavours of lychee, mandarin and ginger spice, all coming together beautifully on the long, clean finish.
- 130 **Sauvignon Blanc Reserva Pionero, Morande, 2021** 29  
Expect a nose packed with citrus notes along with green apple, white peach and pear. The palate showcases refreshing acidity and additional hints of wild flowers and touch of herbs

## CHILE RED

- 314 **Merlot Reserva Pionero, Morande, 2019** 29  
With aromas of ripe plum and wild blackberries, this wine is silky smooth, building to a finish with hints of bitter sweet dark chocolate. Partially aged in oak for six months this Merlot display a wonderful aroma of black fruits, fresh herbs and cinnamon spices.
- 315 **Luis Felipe Edwards Gran Reserva Merlot, Colchagua Valley, 2018** 33  
This is an absolutely classic Chilean Merlot from some of the best vineyards. Big and bold, aged for about a year in a mixture of new and second use French oak barrels. Bursting with dark plum, cassis, bramble with vanilla and chocolate flavours on the end.

This has been described by Isabelle de Nazelle (vineyard owner) as 'Christmas in a bottle', with powerful quince and tropical fruit aromas. Fresh acidity offsets the sweetness.

**Chateau Filhot Grand Cru Classe Sauternes, France, 2010** 49

Quite juicy, with toasty peach and tarte tatin notes laced with honeysuckle and marmalade flavours.

**Pedro Ximenez TRIANA, Bodegas Hidalgo, Sherry, Spain** 40

One of the sweetest wines in the world, PX offers rich, unctuous flavours of currants, chocolate and vanilla, and matches well with vanilla ice cream. This is all about treacle, figs and raisins and is positively sticky.

**SWEET RED** Half Btl

**Maury, Domaine Lafage, Roussillon, France, 2020** 34

Very rich sweet fortified red wine with prune, mocha, caramel and herby flavours, absolutely superb with chocolate desserts or strong cheeses.

**Reciotto Della Valpolicella Fiodora, Veneto, Italy, 2015** 44

Made with the local grape varieties Corvina, Corvinone and Rondinella, which are 37.5cl dried for 3 months before the pressing, in order to concentrate the aromas. After the vinification, the wine age in French oak for about 30 months. Complex, black cherry jam with hints of almonds and spices will go perfect with any sort of cheeses or simply as a meditation wine after dinner.
